The WHO warns that exposure to air pollutants such as PM<sub>2.5</sub> kills millions of people annually. PM<sub>2.5</sub> contains carcinogenic polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons, such as benzo[*a*]pyrene. Concentrations of these pollutants are extremely high in China and India, and some parts of these are transported across borders with potential widespread impacts. In Japan, the atmospheric standard for PM<sub>2.5</sub> has been set, but not for the polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons; this is an urgent issue.

This symposium is organized by the Institute of Nature and Environmental Technology at Kanazawa University and is a satellite symposium of the Joint International Meeting of ACEM/JEMS, inviting specialists from Japan, China, and India. We look forward to the participation of many.
